| <b>Professional Engineer (PE)</b> | <p>Completion of EAC or ETAC ABET accredited engineering curriculum of four years or more.</p> <p><b>Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) examination</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The NCEES FE examination required for registration as a professional engineer is on the Department of Veterans Affairs qualified list of non-federal government licensure and certification examinations, allowing eligible veterans and their dependents to be reimbursed for the cost of the test.</li></ul> <p><b>Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) examination</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The NCEES PE examination required for registration as a professional engineer is on the Department of Veterans Affairs qualified list of non-federal government licensure and certification examinations, allowing eligible veterans and their dependents to be reimbursed for the cost of the test.</li><li>• Ohio Revised Code 4733.11 (C) provides that for a professional engineer's practical experience requirement, or surveying experience, for a professional surveyor's practical experience requirement, in any of the armed forces of the United States or civilian war services may be credited for registration, if the experience is acceptable to the board.</li><li>• Ohio Administrative Code 4733-9-02 (C) specifically provides that engineering experience gained in the armed services is acceptable experience.</li></ul> <p><b>Prioritized Application Processing</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Military applicants have the option to indicate their military status on the application and thereby have their application prioritized for processing.</li></ul> <p><b>Fee Exemption</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ohio Revised Code 4733.15 permits the Board to waive the biennial renewal fee for registrants on active duty with any branch of the armed forces of the United States or a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, including the Ohio National Guard or the national guard of any other state.</li><li>• The Board will also waive renewal and reinstatement fees for any registrant that did not renew the license because the registrant's spouse served in the armed forces on active duty and the service resulted in the registrant's absence from Ohio.</li></ul> <p><b>Waiver of Continuing Professional Development Requirement</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ohio Revised Code 4733.15 permits the Board to waive the continuing professional development requirement for registrants on active duty with any branch of the armed forces of the United States.</li></ul> |
