State Board Revokes Four Professional Engineers' Licenses

At its meeting on February 17, 2010 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors voted to revoke the professional engineer registrations of **Brian Clifford Christenson, George Diefenbach Jr., U Young Park and Bruce Edward Wilson** for failing to comply with the Board's continuing professional development requirement.

Brian Clifford Christenson, a resident of Bucyrus, Ohio, was charged with violations of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 4733.151, 4733.20 (A) (1) and (5), 4733.22 and Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 4733-19-01 and 4733-35-09 for failing to complete 15 hours of continuing education after reporting on his annual renewal that he had completed the annual continuing education requirement. Due to his failure to respond to several requests from the Board to provide documentation that he had completed the continuing education, the Board voted to revoke Mr. Christenson's professional engineer registration.

George Diefenbach Jr., a resident of Seattle, Washington, was charged with violations of ORC 4733.151, 4733.20 (A)(1) and (5), 4733.22 and OAC 4733-19-01 and 4733-35-09 for failing to complete 15 hours of continuing education after reporting on his annual renewal that he had completed the annual continuing education requirement. Due to his failure to respond to several requests from the Board to provide documentation that he had completed the continuing education, the Board voted to revoke Mr. Diefenbach's professional engineer registration.

U Young Park, a resident of Honolulu, Hawaii, was charged with violations of ORC 4733.151, 4733.20 (A)(1) and (5), 4733.22 and OAC 4733-19-01 and 4733-35-09 for failing to complete 15 hours of continuing education after reporting on his annual renewal that he had completed the annual continuing education requirement. Due to his failure to respond to several requests from the Board to provide documentation that he had completed the continuing education, the Board voted to revoke Mr. Park's professional engineer registration.

Bruce Wilson, a resident of Las Vegas, Nevada, was charged with violations of ORC 4733.151, 4733.20 (A)(1) and (5), 4733.22 and OAC 4733-19-01 and 4733-35-09 for failing to complete 15 hours of continuing education after reporting on his annual renewal that he had completed the annual continuing education requirement. Due to his failure to respond to several requests from the Board to provide documentation that he had completed the continuing education, the Board voted to revoke Mr. Wilson's professional engineer registration.
