State Board Issues Final Order

At its meeting on July 16, 2013 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors issued a final order revoking the professional engineer registration of Frank P. Knapp.

Frank P. Knapp, a resident of Delaware, Ohio, was charged with failing to provide evidence that he completed Ohio's continuing education requirement for professional engineers. Despite numerous requests from the Board to provide the documentation over 11 months, Mr. Knapp failed to provide the required documentation. A hearing was held on May 2, 2013 and an independent hearing examiner recommended that the Board revoke Mr. Knapp's professional engineer registration. At its meeting on July 16, 2013 the Board voted to accept the hearing examiner's recommendation and issued a final order.
