State Board Issues Final Order Revoking PE License

At its meeting on October 21, 2014 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors issued a Final Order to revoke the professional registrations of James W. Ballinger.

James W. Ballinger, a resident of Lebanon, OH, was found guilty of violating Ohio Revised Code Section 4733.20 (A) (5) and Ohio Administrative Code Section 4733-35-09, as a result of Mr. Ballinger failing to cooperate with the Board in its investigation of a complaint, and failing to provide information and documents as required by the Board upon its request. The Board voted to revoke Mr. Ballinger's professional engineering and professional surveying registrations effective immediately.

The remaining charges filed against Mr. Ballinger were dismissed without prejudice.
