

**STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND SURVEYORS**

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State Board Accepts Two Settlement Agreements

At its meeting on June 12, 2008 the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors accepted settlement agreements from **Michael Kim Smith, P.E., P.S. of Hamilton, Ohio** and **Dan R. Michael, owner of Clear Creek Environmental of Lebanon, Ohio.**

In October 2007 the Board received a complaint alleging that Michael Kim Smith had submitted signed and sealed engineering plans to the City of Mason for permit approval. Smith's professional engineer and professional surveyor registrations had expired on December 31, 2006. After the Board completed its investigation Smith agreed to enter into a settlement agreement with the Board in which he agreed to pay a \$250.00 fine and to annually renew his professional engineer and professional surveyor registrations on or before the last day of December each year.

In May 2007 the Board received a complaint alleging that Dan R. Michael, an unlicensed individual, had performed a topographic survey on a property for the purpose of designing a septic system. After the Board completed its investigation Michael agreed to enter into a settlement agreement with the Board in which he agreed to immediately cease and desist the unlicensed practice of surveying.

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
